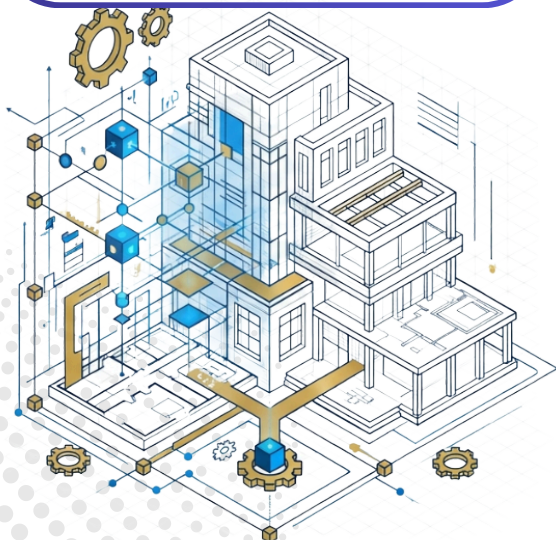
PURPOSE

ACTIVITIES OF THE CENTRE
